

## Utilities Command List

spoken command	action	notes
<b>DB</b>	calls the dictation box	if you have the SP dictation box, make sure you rename the original DB command to something else
<b>Glide</b> <direction> <speed>	For example, <b>glide down slow</b>	Use the configuration manager (group 2, configure glide speed) to configure the three speeds. The higher the number the slower the scroll speed.
<1-100> <b>down</b> <1-100>	<b>33 down 75</b> places the mouse cursor 33% of the way to the right and 75% of the way down from the top left corner.	The <b>grid</b> program must be installed. This command works with either the graphical grid displayed or not.
<b>Grid</b> <option>	The options are: <b>Close</b> <b>Help</b> <b>Show</b> <b>Stop</b>	close and stop do the same thing, show opens up the grid display.
<b>My Plates</b>	Displays the <b>plates</b> application	
<b>Plates</b> <dictation>	Goes directly to the dictated category, if you have multiple categories defined	
<b>Speech Commander</b>		Opens the program and places the icon in the system tray. Double clicking on the icon or doing a right-click on it and choosing show will display the window to you.
<b>Mike Level</b>		Opens the Mike level program, places the icon in the system tray. Double clicking on the icon will cause the icon to be opened in the task

		manager, where you can open it up as normal. It's quirky, but for now it works.
